Blanket Drive Report

I began to plan my leadership service project for black belt, around the end of March of 2007. Previously my dad had been volunteering at a homeless shelter downtown, called, New Genesis. My dad told me that they were in desperate need of blankets, so I decided to find a way to collect blankets for the shelter and the service project. I printed and handed out flyers from April 1st to April 14th. I originally planned to collect blankets from April 1st to April 21st. My goal was to collect 50 blankets.

I had a lot of support by my family and teachers. My Spanish teacher and math teacher helped spread the word to their classes. Master Bill also did this, and let me hang up flyers and put a collecting bin in the Dojang. My Pastor allowed me to speak about it at my church. My sister put a bin at her job to collect some. My mom spread the word at her job. My dad helped me with everything. And of course, all the people that contributed played a large part.

By the 21st I was only $\frac{3}{5}$ of the way to my goal and the Blanket Drive was "over." I decided to push the deadline back another week, to the 28th, to give people more time.

On Saturday, April 28th, my dad loaded the back of the van with all of the blankets. Then my parents and I drove to the shelter to drop off the blankets. Meanwhile, some men (working at and residents of) the shelter helped unload the van. He went inside and took pictures of the blankets of the director of the shelter.



That day there was a total of 37 blankets (and 18 pillowcases) given away. I later passed out Thankyou cards to all of the people who helped make this project a success.

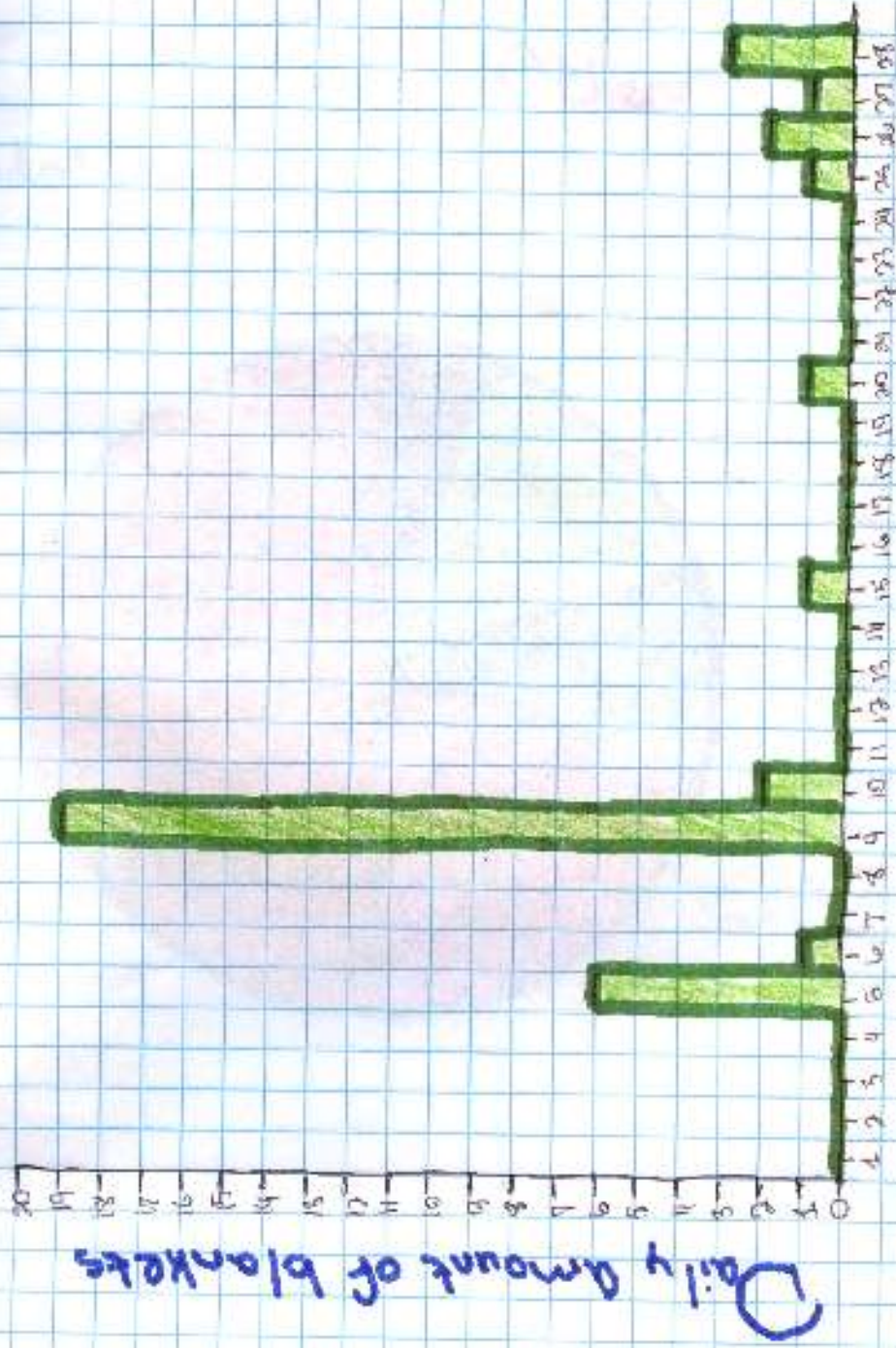
