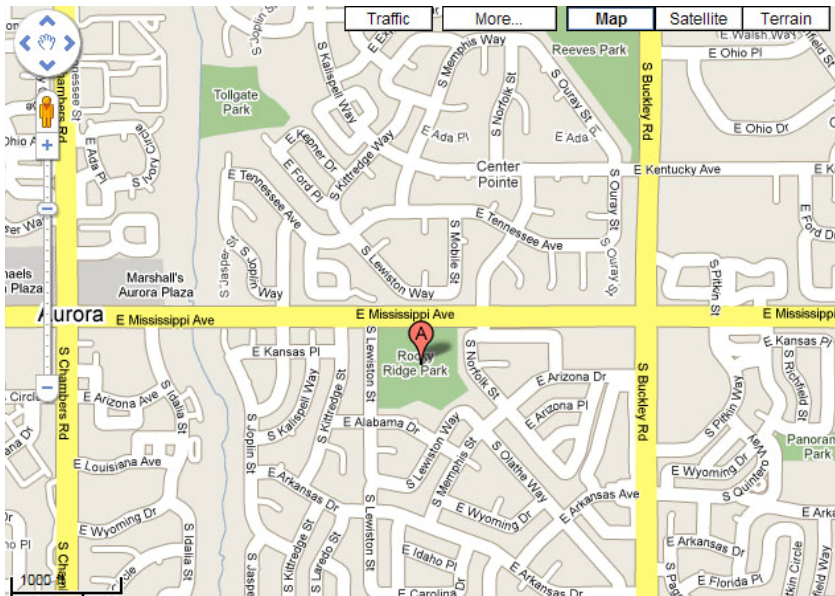

Event Rules

There is NO NEED to preregister for any event! For instance, to compete in forms, simply go to the forms ring, get in the back of the line, and wait your turn to compete. Competitors will earn between one and five tickets for their performance, based on quality. **Then, in contrast to a tournament where the judges just give a score, the judges will offer tips to help the student improve.**

Forms - Do your form and have judges give you specific critiques on how to make it better.

Creative Forms - Do the same, with or without music

Weapons Forms - Do your form with a martial arts weapon

Trick Kick Battle - Come bust your best XMA moves in a battle against other trickers.

Largest Synchronized Form - How many people can you get from your school to do a form together without errors?

NEW – Water Balloon Grappling – Tape a water balloon to your opponent and try to pop it with takedowns and sweeps.

Paintfoot Sparring - Wear a white t-shirt over your hogu and red or blue paint on your feet. Try to mark up your partner to win. (No Head Contact)

Longest Double Kicks - Can you make it all the way around the park without breaking rhythm?

Padded Sword Sparring - Face off against your friends!

Longest Flying Kick - We'll break out the tape measure and see how far you can go.

my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

I/ The MINOR fully understand the nature of Taekwondo/Martial Arts/Weaponry * Tournaments and acknowledge my/ the minor's experience and capabilities and believe I/ the minor are qualified to participant in such a tournament. I /The Minor further acknowledge that I/The minor am /are aware that the tournament will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the tournament. I/The minor further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I/ or the minor will immediately discontinue further participation in the tournament.

I/ THE MINOR FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a) TAEKWONDO/MARTIAL ARTS/WEAPONRY* TOURNAMENTS INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my /or The minor's own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Tournament, the condition in which the Tournament takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me/or The minor or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I/THE MINOR FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS AND DAMAGES I/The MINOR incur as a result of my participation, or that of the minor, in the Tournament. I/The Minor understand the U.S.T.U./tournament rules and agree to follow all the competition / Tournament rules. I further agree that any pictures taken of me, or by me in connection with "The White Tiger Marital Arts Championship" can be used by the Tournament Director for publicity or promotion without compensation.
