Divisions

Divisions will be broken down by age, weight, gender, and experience. Competitors will be able to select a different experience level for each division. This will help someone who may want to do forms at their level, but spar at a higher level. This will also help people who might be a black belt in Taekwondo, but a beginning grappler.

Registration Instructions

In order for the tournament to run smoothly, we are accepting preregistration ONLY. However, you may register online until Midnight, September 23rd.

The winners of each division will receive points as stated below

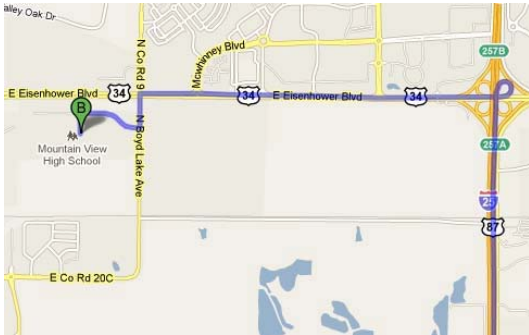

- Turn **1st right** @ **Mountain Lion Drive**
- School will be on your left.

Rules and Mandatory Equipment

Uniform: Recognized martial arts uniform/rashguard for grappling

Safety Equipment: - WTF/USAT Approved!

Shin & Instep, Forearm, Head Gear, Chest Protector, Groin Cup (Males, worn on inside of pants). A mouthpiece is mandatory! For point style sparring appropriate gear is required. For grappling, cup and mouthpiece are required.

Traditional Forms and Olympic Style Sparring will be judged by current USAT rules. Point sparring will be judged by current CKA Rules. Breaking competitors will have three chances per board and must provide their own breaking materials. Breaking, Creative Forms, Group Forms, and Weapons Forms will be judged for style, skill, balance and overall presentation. Creative, Group, and Weapons forms may have music and have a time limit of 3 minutes. Blaster Pad Sparring – Knock your opponent down or out of the ring! Best 2 out of 3 wins. No skill divisions.
