This year we have decided to try a different venue. Although Metro State University was an amazing place to hold a tournament, having it at Aurora Quest gives us some key advantages

***There will now be NO PARKING FEES**

***We can run the entire event in one day, so teams coming from farther away won't need hotels.**

***We will also ELIMINATE ALL SPECTATOR FEES.**

We will use Daedo for all black belt matches. We will also be offering FREE ENTRY to current national team (AAU/USAT) members.

Demo team members who enter any other event in the tournament can add the demo event **for free.**

We look forward to an efficient tournament with padded rings (6+ rings) and electronic scoring. We will be offering online registration. Please see the tournament web page www.kattaekwondo.com/tournament.htm for more information and registration, and do not hesitate to let us know if you have any questions or concerns.

This tournament is the third in a series that also features the **White Tiger Championships** and **Twin Dragons Tournament**. The events average nearly 350 competitors from 35-40 schools and programs.

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Events Contested

Standard Events – Traditional Forms, Traditional Team Forms, Creative Team Forms, Olympic Sparring, Demo Team, Grappling, Weapons, Breaking.

Special Events – Junk Weapons, Cloud Chess, Blaster Pads, Totem Forms, Trick Kick Battle.

New for 2017 – *Totem Forms* – Do a form on your partner’s shoulders. All color belts do Tae Guek 4, all black belts do TaeBaek.

Divisions

Divisions will be broken down by age, weight, gender, and experience. Competitors will be able to select a different experience level for each event. This will help someone who may want to do forms at their level, but spar at a higher level. This will also help people who might be a black belt in Taekwondo, but a beginning grappler.

Junk Weapons, Cloud Chess, Totem Forms, Trick Kick Battle, Weapons, Traditional Team Forms, Creative Team Forms, and Cloud Chess will **all have 6 divisions**.

Teams will be placed in the division of the highest member. Thus a team with a black belt and a color belt will compete in the BLACK BELTS DIVISION. Consider this when making your teams for these events.

Registration Instructions

In order for the tournament to run smoothly, we are accepting preregistration ONLY. However, you may register online until Midnight, WEDNESDAY April 19th.
(Note, this year the deadline is WEDNESDAY and not Thursday as before).

All competitors, coaches, and referees are encouraged to register ONLINE at www.kattaekwondo.com/tournament.htm After registering online, print and sign the waiver form and bring it with you to the tournament. You’re all set!

For those wishing to register by paper, please note that the application must be postmarked by Monday, April 17th. You **must** pay with certified check or money order. After Monday April 11th, the application must be hand carried to the Korean Academy.

You DO NOT need to be a member of USTU/USAT/AAU or any other governing body for this tournament.

Demo Teams - Athletes who enter any regular event can enter the demo team event for free. For competitors not entering any other event in the tournament, there is a flat fee of \$200/team. **Note: Winning teams will earn team trophies, NOT the magnetic medals.**

Location

The Tournament will be at: 17315 E 2nd Ave, Aurora, CO 80011

Registration Prices

\$45 for the first event and \$15 for each additional event. There is NO COST FOR SPECTATORS.

Match Numbers

ALL SPARRING MATCHES will be numbered. The first number is the ring and the second is the match. So for instance if you are match 2-7 that means you will be the 7th match in Ring 2. This will help competitors know when they will go.

In order for this to work, we will post brackets online on Friday, April 21st. Please check the brackets and make sure you are in the correct division.

Although the numbers should be very close, there may be competitor no shows that could cause matches to progress differently, so stay by your ring when you are up within 5 matches.

You will be responsible for having the correct color hogu as well as all your gear on BEFORE you are called. If you have any questions please ask the person running the ring or your coach for help.

Official Hashtag - Over the next few months post the workouts you do each day and what you learned with the hashtag [#LWC2017](https://www.facebook.com/hashtag/LWC2017). **Three of the statuses will be chosen (posts must be public) and the posters will win special prizes at the event.** On Facebook and Twitter you can click on the hashtag and see how other athletes are preparing.



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Prizes

The winners of each division will receive medals. All 5 year olds and under will receive at least the bronze medal. The winners of each division will also receive 3 points (Gold Medal), 2 Points (Silver Medal) or 1 point (Bronze Medal). You can receive a maximum of 3 points per event.

The medals represent a piece in a puzzle that can be completed by also winning medals in the **White Tiger Championships (2018)** and **Twin Dragons Tournament (2019)**.



Phoenix Medal – Since so many people have already completed the Tae-Kwon-Do parts of the medal we have added the Black Phoenix bonus medal. There are TWO conditions to receive this medal.

- 1.) You must already have a GOLD WOLF MEDAL (2017 or 2014)
- 2.) The Phoenix medal only comes in GOLD.

Trophies

Grand Champions – ALL COMPETITORS who earn at least ELEVEN (11) points will receive a 24K Gold Plated Championship Ring. Note that we cannot guarantee sizes.

Demo Teams – Demo Team winners will receive team trophies.

Cloud-Chess Grand Champion – The winner of all divisions together will also earn a special trophy.

I/ The MINOR fully understand the nature of Taekwondo/Martial Arts/Weaponry * Tournaments and acknowledge my/ the minor's experience and capabilities and believe I/ the minor are qualified to participant in such a tournament. I /The Minor further acknowledge that I/The minor am /are aware that the tournament will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the tournament. I/The minor further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe, I/ or the minor will immediately discontinue further participation in the tournament.
